About the DRD Financial Assistance Program

- Financial assistance is available from July 1, 2018 through June 30, 2019, provided funds are available.
- Financial assistance can be used for most DRD programs, but is not offered for drop-in class fees, programs costing \$20 or less, one-day activities, one-on-one or low-enrollment programs, trips and certain other specialty programs.
- Programs must meet minimum registration levels before assistance is an option.
- Following application review and approval, all verification paperwork will immediately be shredded.
- Funding may not be used until you receive notice of your award.
- If assistance is awarded and not used by June 30, 2019, residents will not be eligible to apply the following year.
- Assistance funds are provided through the Desert Recreation Foundation and awards will not exceed the funds made available by the Foundation.
- Desert Recreation District updates the financial assistance policy annually.

Qualification is based on the HUD 2018 State Income Limits

Refer to the chart on the following page to see if you qualify. If your income is:

Extremely Low

You may receive 75% off the cost of activities, up to \$150 maximum in financial assistance per family member per fiscal year.

Very Low

You may receive 50% off the cost of activities, up to \$150 maximum in financial assistance per family member per fiscal year.

What do I need to apply?

You must be a resident and live within DRD's boundaries to apply. (You may pick up a map at DRD headquarters in Indio to see where we offer programs and activities.)

You must provide:

- Current utility bill to verify your address
- Picture ID
- Copy of current Federal tax return to confirm household income

How do I apply?

Applications can be downloaded from our website at MyRecreationDistrict.com or you can pick one up at the District's offices in Indio.

Complete and sign your application, then mail, fax or deliver it, along with all required verification documents to:
